Financial education materials, instructional videos, and professional development events augment the 3-9 month immersive competition. No prior knowledge of economics and finance is needed to administer The Stock Market Game.

Whether you teach in a classroom, mentor students in an afterschool program, are a homeschool parent, or just want to learn more, the Stock Market Game is a versatile tool designed to help users build a fundamental understanding of investing while providing real-world practice in math, English Language Arts, economics, social studies, and other subjects.
